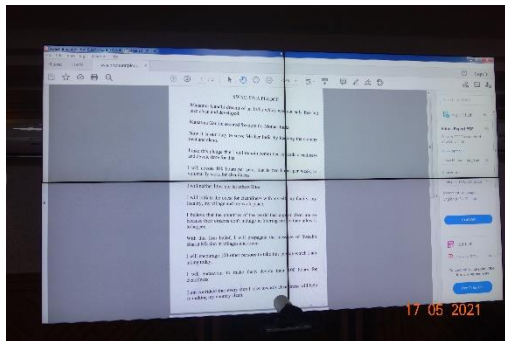

Swacchta Pakhwada 2021

Northeastern Regional Load Despatch Centre observed Swacchta Pakhwada from 17th to 31st May 2021.

1. All employees took the Swacchta Shapath on 17th May 2021. The oath was administered by Chief General Manager (I/C), Sh. Nabarun Roy and Head of HR, Sh. V. F Desouza in Hindi and English respectively. All employees joined through WEBEX.



2. On 19th May, Dr. N. R Deb, visiting Part Time Medical Doctor of NERLDC, briefed the outsourced workers regarding COVID-19 Appropriate Behaviour and cleared queries of the workers on Vaccination, COVID and Health measures in general and during the pandemic.



3. Dr. Sonali Shinde Tesia, Consultant Psychiatrist (MD from NIMHANS- Bangalore) delivered a health talk on “COVID-19 Appropriate behaviour: The only way to break the chain of transmission” through WEBEX for employees and their family members.



4. To extend relief among needy people in the locality, **200** number of hygiene kits with each kit containing a bottle of handwash, sanitizer and mask were distributed on 26th May 2021. To minimise gathering of people during the ongoing lockdown in Meghalaya, Village headmen of two localities, Lapalangi and Nongrah, along with ASHA workers were invited to NERLDC to collect the hygiene kits. CGM (I/C) along with Head of Departments handed over the kits to the local authorities.

Outsourced workers of NERLDC were also presented the hygiene kits.





5. Essay competition on topic “*Impact of COVID-19 on Indian Power Sector*” was conducted among employees on 26th May. Dr. B. S Jha, ED- Itanagar, POWERGRID judged the competition and declared the winners through email.

6. Plantation of saplings was carried out by Head of Departments and Chief General Manager, Sh. Nabarun Roy on 27th May in office premises. As an environment friendly measure and to lift the morale of employees, saplings were presented to all employees on the same day.
